QUALIFYING SQUADS LIMITED TO 88 ENTRANTS EACH

GENERAL RULES, REGULATIONS, AND INFORMATION

1. Entry fee will be \$40.00. Money received for awards will be returned 100%. All USBC Rules and Regulations will govern this tournament.
2. Entrants must be USBC Youth members sanctioned through LIUSBCA. Non-Sanctioned youth bowlers living in Nassau or Suffolk County may purchase a membership card before entering (\$14.00). Sanction cards will be checked. **Youth bowlers who have bowled in adult singles cash competition for scholarships are not eligible to enter.** This is a SCRATCH qualifying and match game event. There will be at least four (4) divisions: Preps (boys and girls 11 years of age and under), Queens (girls 12 years of age and older), Kings Junior (boys ages 12 to 14), and Kings Senior (boys ages 15 and over). Ages are as of August 1, 2008. If girls' entries are sufficient, the Queens and Preps divisions will be split. **No reentry permitted.**
3. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-accepted basis regardless of division. Entrants in the prep and junior divisions will be given the option of receiving refunds or competing in higher divisions if their divisions are canceled for lack of sufficient entries (minimum 10 entries each division). **Lanes will be assigned according to division 20 minutes before the beginning of the squad. Thereafter, lanes will be assigned in sequence regardless of division.**
4. The Qualifying Round will consist of 5 games across 10 lanes. At least four (4) qualifiers from each division will advance to the final round. The top qualifier each squad and the next highest scores regardless of squad will advance. If a division has twenty-four (24) or more entries, eight qualifiers will advance (top qualifiers each squad plus the next six (6) highest scores, regardless of squad). If an entrant qualifies in more than one squad, the higher score shall be the qualifying score. If scores are identical, the entry with the highest game will qualify. Ties for qualifying position will be broken by the highest game in the five (5) games of qualifying. A tie for the last qualifying position will be determined by a one game roll-off at a time set by the tournament chairman. Tournament entries close on November 2, 2008.
5. Finalists will compete in one-game matches. In match games, a double elimination method is used whereby a contestant losing two (2) matches is eliminated from further competition. Pairings for the initial matches will be based upon total qualifying pinfall. The two squad-leaders will be placed in 1st and 2nd positions according to their qualifying pinfall. Remaining qualifiers will be seeded in the order of qualifying scores. If scores are identical, the higher individual game will receive the higher seed. Ties in any of these matches will be resolved by a 9th & 10th frame roll-off.
6. THE WINNERS OF THE FINAL MATCHES WILL BE CROWNED JUNIOR MASTERS CHAMPIONS.
