TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1) This tournament is open to all sanctioned USBC bowlers who are members of leagues sanctioned through LIUSBCA. A resident of Nassau or Suffolk County who is not sanctioned this season may purchase an affiliate card (\$19.00). Proof of residence in the form of a valid NYS Driver's License or NYS Personal ID Card with a Nassau or Suffolk address is required. NO OTHER FORM OF PROOF IS ACCEPTABLE.
- 2) The team Captain, or an authorized representative, has the authority to substitute bowlers to take the place in the lineup of those originally entered. Tournament committee reserves the final authority regarding the qualification of substitutes. Handicap, division assignments, and entry fees will be adjusted if necessary.
- 3) Lanes will be assigned prior to the scheduled squad time. Team pairing will be permitted only when both team captains or authorized representatives have checked in at time of selection.
- 4) All entrants will bowl three (3) games on one pair of lanes in each event. Doubles and Singles events will be bowled on separate pairs of lanes. A substitute in the singles event ONLY is not permitted.
- 5) A reserved squad time will be honored only if a complete and fully paid entry is received. When lanes are filled on a requested date and time, the next open requested date and time would be scheduled.
- 6) There are three divisions as follows:
 - a) **CLASSIC**: OPEN TEAMS with a total entering average of 820 or more; DOUBLES with a total entering average of 410 or more; and SINGLES with an entering average of 205 or more.
 - b) **REGULAR**: All OPEN TEAMS, OPEN DOUBLES, and OPEN SINGLES with entering averages lower than CLASSIC. Regular bowlers may bowl in the classic division by paying the proper entry fees and indicating this on the entry blank.
 - c) **WOMEN**: All TEAMS, DOUBLES, and SINGLES entrants whose roster is composed of women only. Women bowlers may bowl in the Regular or Classic division by paying the proper entry fees and indicating this on the entry blank.
- 7) HANDICAP will be assigned as follows:
 - a) **CLASSIC** division entrants will receive no handicap.
 - b) **REGULAR & WOMEN** division handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between the bowler/team entering average and: 820 in the TEAM event; 410 in the DOUBLES event; and 205 in the SINGLES. Series handicaps will be assigned.
- 8) Entrants must use their highest 2008-2009 final book average (21 games or more). Winter averages take precedence over summer averages. If an entrant's current average for 21 games or more is ten (10) pins higher than the highest 2008-2009 final book average, the bowler must use the current average (USBC Rule 319(a)2). If entrant has no 2008-2009 average, a current average (21 games or more) may be used. Entrants without entering averages must enter at averages set by the Tournament Management (women not less than 160, men not less than 175).
- 9) Bowlers may enter more than once in any event. Rule 315b will be in effect. When an entrant bowls more than once in any event, the HIGHEST score bowled in that event shall count towards the ALL EVENTS score.
- 10) No more than two PBA cardholders are permitted on a Regular Division team entry and only one PBA cardholder shall be permitted on a Regular Division doubles entry.
- 11) Proper attire shall be worn at all times during tournament competition. Committee has final authority.
