BOWLER OF THE MONTH

The Long Island USBC Association will award BOWLER OF THE MONTH plaques in THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES:

MALE: REGULAR, SUPER, YOUTH, and SENIOR.

FEMALE: REGULAR, SUPER, YOUTH, and SENIOR

The REGULAR and SENIOR categories are handicapped; the SUPER and YOUTH categories are scratch.

In addition, all BOWLERS OF THE MONTH are automatically eligible for an end-of-season roll-off to determine the BOWLERS OF THE YEAR. We will crown EIGHT Bowler of the Year in June 2009.

You are an important part of this program. We need your active participation by furnishing our office with the information from your league. All we need is your report of the highest series bowled in your league during the month in these categories.

Here are the simple rules for you to follow:

1. Determine the highest handicap series rolled in your league by a regular bowler and a senior bowler, and the highest scratch series rolled by an adult bowler and by a youth bowler. If a senior rolled the highest handicap series, use that score for both divisions but send separate applications. Mixed leagues should file the highest scores for both males and females.
2. Submit the highest scratch series rolled if it is at least 725 for a male adult, 650 for a female adult, 675 for a male youth, and 600 for a female youth.
3. Complete the entry form for each score. Use the actual average for the bowler at the time he/she rolled the series. You only have to report the scratch series; we will handicap and sort the scores.
4. If a senior bowler, please enter his/her birthday for verification purposes.
5. Send them to our office so that we receive it on or before the 15th of the month following the month that the score qualified.

Each winner will receive a personal letter of congratulations. The plaque for the first-place winner will be presented by one of our directors at a league session. Each secretary who enters will receive the results for that month.

It's that simple. Please help us honor your bowlers. Send us your highest scores each month.
