1. Entrants must be USBC Youth members sanctioned through LIUSBCA. Non-Sanctioned youth bowlers living in Nassau or Suffolk County may purchase a membership card before entering (\$14.00). Sanction cards will be checked. Final standings may be delayed pending verification in the association office. Youth bowlers who have bowled in adult singles cash competition for scholarships are not eligible to enter.
2. All USBC Rules and regulations will govern this tournament.
3. Entrants must use their highest 2007-2008 final book average (21 games or more). Winter averages take precedence over summer averages. If entrant has no 2007-2008 average, a current average (12 games or more) may be used. Current averages will be verified with league coaches. Entrants without an entering average according to this rule will be placed in the highest division.
4. No telephone reservations accepted. Entries will be processed on first-received, first-served basis. Please mail your entries early. Bowlers may reenter. Entries will close on October 26, 2008
5. Lanes will be assigned according to division or preference 20 minutes before the beginning of the squad. Thereafter, lanes will be assigned in sequence regardless of division
6. No refund of entry fees for no-shows. Substitutions will be permitted.
7. Classifications will be according to the list on the front of this entry. Bowlers must compete in their own average class. Boys and girls will bowl in separate classes unless either class does not receive 10 entries. Then all entrants in that class will bowl together.
8. Trophies will be awarded in all classifications. The ratio for awards per average class is 1:10 entries per class. Duplicate trophies will be awarded in case of ties. Bowlers cannot win more than one trophy.
9. Entire amount collected for awards will be returned to bowlers in the form of awards.
10. All trophies will be presented at the LIJBA Awards Day in May 2009.
11. Committee reserves the right to check bowling balls for conformity with USBC Rules. All non-conforming balls will be retained until the conclusion of the squad
